SILENT AUCTION GUIDELINES

An opening bid must meet or exceed the minimum opening bid. Each subsequent bid must exceed the previous bid by at least the minimum raise shown on the bidding system. Bids not meeting these requirements will be disqualified.

In the event of a 'bidding war' in progress at the close of the silent auction, the top bidder when the auction closes will be the winner.

All items in the silent auction will close at the same time. The Auction Committee will inform the guests when the silent auction is closing.

The Auction Committee reserves the right to combine and categorize all donated items.

Your gifts are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law. The tax-deductible portion is the difference between the amount paid and the fair market value.

GENERAL AUCTION TERMS

All sales are final. There are no exchanges/refunds, unless donor is unable to fulfill his obligation as described.

All winnings should be claimed at the end of the auction and taken home. All purchases must be removed from the venue, The Foundry at Puritan Mill, the night of the event. Remote bidders may make an appointment to pick up their winnings from the Georgia Tech Catholic Center the week of March 4th by calling 404-892-6759 or emailing cmartineck@gtcatholic.org.
